SHARING GOD'S FINAL WARNING IN THE LATTER DAYS!!

"For I know that after My death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger through the work of your hands" (Deut 31:29).

Today, we are in the latter days spoke by Moses. We have seen thousand of year go by since these words Moses of Deuteronomy! "And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished, That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying, Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee. For I know thy rebellion, and thy stiff neck: behold, while I am yet alive with you this day, ye have been rebellious against the LORD; and how much more after my death? Gather unto me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them. For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to

anger through the work of your hands" (Dent 31:24-29).

At the time of Jeremiah, he was warning both the House of Judah and the House of Israel of the destruction, when the people turned their back on God and His laws. Before Solomon's temple was destroyed, God destroyed the tabernacle in Shiloh. Jer 26:6-8, "Then will I make this house like Shiloh, and will make this city a curse to all the nations of the earth. So the priests and the prophets and all the people heard Jeremiah speaking these words in the house [temple] of the LORD. Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded him to speak unto all the people, that the priests and the prophets and all the people took him, saying, Thou shalt surely die."

Both places were destroyed because the people would not listen to God and His words. Jeremiah warned the people, "Thus saith the LORD; Stand in the court of the LORD's house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to worship in the LORD's house, all the words that I command thee to

speak unto them; diminish not a word: If so be they will hearken, [listen] and turn every man from his evil way, that I may repent Me of the evil, which I purpose to do unto them because of the evil of their doings. And thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD; If ye will not hearken to Me, to walk in My law, which I have set before you, To hearken to the words of My servants the prophets, whom I sent unto you, both rising up early, and sending them, but ye have not hearkened; Then will I make this house like Shiloh, and will make this city a curse to all the nations of the earth. So the priests and the prophets and all the people heard Jeremiah speaking these words in the house [temple] of the LORD. Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded him to speak unto all the people, that the priests and the prophets and all the people took him, saying, Thou shalt surely die. Why hast thou prophesied in the name of the LORD, saying, This house shall be like Shiloh, and this city shall be desolate without an inhabitant? And all the people were gathered against Jeremiah in the



house of the LORD" (Jer 26:2-9). Today, in the midst of a contested Presidential race, we see God has turned His back on the United State, who are the people of the House of Israel. Why, because we have turned our back on Him! Why do we think we can always have peace and goodness if we don't follow God's laws, statutes and judgments? Notice, 1 Sam 4:3-4, to see why the people thought they would be saved because the Ark of the Covenant was in Shiloh. "And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies. So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts which dwelleth between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God." But God had other plans for Shiloh!

In Psalms 78:56-60, we find the answers: "Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not His testimonies: But turned back, and d e a l t unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a deceitful bow. F o r they provoked Him to anger with their high

places, and moved Him to jealousy with their graven images. When God heard this, He was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel: So that He forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent which He placed among men; And delivered His strength into captivity, and His glory into the enemy's hand °"

Even when we are in despair, we should look to the words God gave to Joshua! 'Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them. Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou may observe to do according to all the law, which Moses My servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou may prosper whithersoever thou go. This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou may observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismaved: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou go" (Josh 1:6-9).

Our assignment today is to: "Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and He shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD" (Ps 27:14). Ps 31:23-24 "0 love the LORD, all ye His saints: for the LORD preserves the faithful, and plentifully rewards the proud doer. Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD." And in Isa 41:6, "They helped every one his neighbour; and every one said to his brother, Be of good courage."
